Self Asessment Rapid Access


AskSARA is a tool developed to assist individuals with disabilities in finding solutions to daily challenges.

By linking to our database, users can complete a self-assessment that includes a series of questions related to daily living. Based on their responses, a personalised report is generated that provides advice, hints, tips, and recommendations for assistive technology solutions and local support services.

AskSARA licenses are available for purchase for local councils, large charities, and other organisations to provide free assistance to their constituents, employees, or beneficiaries.

Additionally, training is also available to licensees, including face-to-face or online presentations to external and internal stakeholders, as well as residents and beneficiaries as part of the launch process.

Vendor portal

Retailers and manufacturers can create a vendor portal account, which allows them to manage their listings by adding or removing them and updating their details to ensure accuracy. The order in which their listings appear is based on the last time they updated, so it is encouraged to log in frequently as a result in higher placement on the list.

The advantages of the database extend beyond end-users to include both manufacturers and retailers. Living Made Easy uploads products and their corresponding information, supplied directly by the manufacturers, onto the website. Retailers who stock the products are then able to add pricing, details and links to their own website's product page at no cost.
