

Welcome to years of stress-free flushing, with your easy-to-clean, easy-to-use Eezy-Flush. Check first that your pack contains all four of the components shown in the picture below: the tubular stalk (top left); the cap (top right); the collar (bottom left); and the double-sided adhesive ring (bottom right). If any are missing, call or email us for a replacement.



Step-by-step fitting instructions

- **1. Place** the collar over the flush mechanism on your toilet and make sure it sits cleanly on to the ceramic of the cistern. The Eezy-Flush is designed to fit over all top-mounted push-button mechanisms up to 65mm (2.5in) across.
- **2. Press** out and discard the adhesive ring's central disc. Peel the protective backing paper off one side of the ring (it doesn't matter which side) and attach it under the rim of the collar.



3. Push the tubular stalk into the cap, making sure that the notch on the stalk fits over the small post inside the cap. There's no need for glue.



- **4. Centre** the collar over your flush mechanism and try the assembled cap and stalk to make sure that it operates the flush freely. If you have a split-button mechanism, rotate the collar to line up the double raindrop mark on the collar with the full-flush button and the single raindrop mark with the restricted-flush button.
- **5. Remove** the remaining backing paper from the adhesive ring once you're happy with the collar's position and press the collar firmly into place. Then drop in the assembled cap and stalk. Aligning the arrow-head on the cap with the double raindrop on the collar will give you a full flush; aligning it with the single raindrop will give you a restricted flush.



Trouble-shooting

You can clean your Eezy-Flush with any normal household or bathroom cleaner.

If you need to remove the Eezy-Flush for any reason, use a spatula or screwdriver to ease the adhesive ring off the cistern. If necessary, spread a little household glue on the ring to re-attach it.
